- Pushed for a fairer 'speaker selection' process
- Advocated for a dedicated fund for Disabled delegates who require additional support to participate at Conference
- Visited over 18 CLPs and spoken at 11 events to discuss how Conference works.

My goal for the next two years is to:

- Address the barriers some CLPs have in participating in Conference
- Open the work of the CAC further for members so members have the knowledge to ensure Conference works for them.

In October 2018 I undertook a membership survey with over 300 people taking part. I was humbled to receive a 95% satisfaction rate. I hope that confidence in my work remains and you nominate and elect me again.
