Dear Ms Wimborne-Idrissi,

Notice of Outcome of NEC Panel Decision: Termination of Membership of the Labour Party

We are writing to inform you that the Labour Party (**the Party**) has concluded its investigation into the allegation that you had committed a Prohibited Act pursuant to Chapter 2, Clause I.5.B.v of the Labour Party Rule Book (**the Rules**).¹

A panel of the National Executive Committee (**the NEC Panel**) met on 15 December 2022 and considered all of the evidence that the Party put to you and any evidence submitted by you in response.

The NEC Panel then made findings of fact and then applied the Rules to those findings. We have set out the findings of the NEC Panel below.

Summary of the Findings of the NEC Panel

Allegation 1; Support for RESIST, LIEN and LAW, 2021

The NEC Panel had regard to the written representations of Ms Wimborne-Idrissi submitted and received on 18 October 2022.

The NEC Panel found, on the balance of probabilities, that Ms Wimborne-Idrissi had attended and spoken at the "Resist! At the Rialto" event in Brighton on 27 September 2021.

The NEC Panel considered that this event had been organised by RESIST, LIEN and LAW.

The NEC Panel concluded that Ms Wimborne-Idrissi had, in its opinion, demonstrated the type of support for REIST, LIEN and LAW prohibited by Chapter 2, Clause I.5.B.v of the Rules.

Consequently, your membership of the Party stands terminated. You are no longer entitled to attend any Party meetings or to exercise any other rights associated with membership of the Party.
